By Gordon Winch & Illustrated by Patrick Shirvington


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Bestselling children's author Gordon Winch takes us to visit some of Australia's most loved animals and marvel at their clever camouflage.

Award-winning artist Patrick Shirvington evokes the beauty of the Australian landscape and the unique creatures living there.

Can you find all the creatures hiding in the pages of the book?



Themes:

- Hide and Seek
- Australiana
- Flora
- Fauna

Discussion Questions & Activities:

- Can you recall how many creatures are mentioned in the story?
- Enjoy finding all the hidden creatures on each page.
- Which creature is your favourite and why?
- Think of an animal that isn't in the story and write your own description of that animal, starting with 'I am a...' then complete the scene by making a picture of the animal and its surrounds. Make sure to try and camouflage your animal in your picture!
- How many of these creatures have you seen in real life? Where did you see them? Have you seen any in their natural habitat?
- How important is the habitat of each of these creatures to their survival? As a class, research how environmental factors may play a part in the well being of each of the animals.
- Do you think it is a co-incidence that the creatures are able to camouflage into their surroundings?
 Explore.
- Arrange an excursion to a local park, zoo or wildlife centre to study more about our natural
 environment. From this, the students can choose a creature to study and present a report about,
 including such facts about the animal's habitat, natural predators, prey, if it is endangered and it's
 life expectancy.
- Make a comprehensive list of other Australian native birds, animals and plants that are not mentioned in the story.
