Where Are You, Banana?



Themes:

- Dot
- Feeling helpless & worried

- Not giving up
- Being resourceful

Discussion Points:

- What sort of dog do you think Banana is?
- Do you own a pet? If so, what sort of pet? How important is it in your life?
- What are some of the special characteristics about your pet that makes it so special to you?
- Why do pets make such great companions?
- If you don't own a pet, and you could have any pet that you wanted, what would you choose and why? What name would you give it?
- Roddy and Banana had a very close bond. What words would you use to describe how Roddy felt when Banana went missing?
- Have you ever been in this situation? How did you feel?
- What characteristics does Roddy show in this story?
- What are some of the things that you can do to try and keep your pets safe?
- As a class, come up with a list of things that you could do to find a lost pet.
- Roddy was resourceful in the way that he rescued Banana. When have you used your imagination to come up with a solution to a problem?

Activities:

- One way to help find a pet is by putting posters up in your neighbourhood. Design your own poster trying to find Banana.
- Owing a dog like Banana is a big responsibility. Conduct a basic research project on the things that you need to do and have in order to look after a dog and keep it safe and healthy.
