

Billie's Underwater Adventure

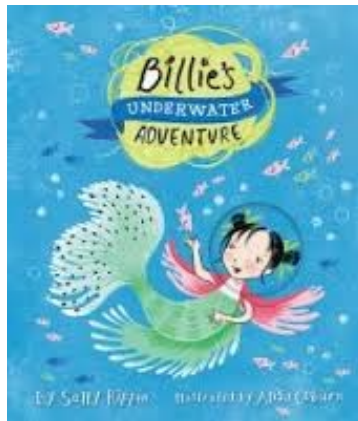

Discussion Points

- Why do you think that Billie didn't want to go to Kinder? Do you sometimes feel that way about going to school?
- How did Billie react when she couldn't be a mermaid? Have you ever reacted like this when something didn't go the way that you wanted it to?
- Who and what helped Billie get over her disappointment of not being a mermaid?
- The children all imagined that they were sea creatures? Do you ever play games like this with your friends?
- Can you name some of the sea creatures that were in their 'Underwater Adventure'?
- The children all had a delicious sea banquet of items like seashell cakes, starfish pies and seaweed spaghetti. As a class, look at the page spread of this and see how many others you can see.

Activities:

- Just like the children do at the end of the story, make and decorate 'sea creature mobiles' out of paper plates. Then display them all around your classroom!
