- What is it that makes the relationship that you have with your Dad special?
- How would you describe the children in this story? Do they seem happy?
- How has the author used boldness in the text to highlight what they are saying?
- As a class, write a list of 'How To Be a Great Dad'. Think of all the things that you do in your everyday life with your Dad and all the things a Dad might do.

### **Activity:**

- Create a poster of all the 'amazing' things that you do with your Dad. Use bold colours like the ones used in the story and add other words that describe how great he is.
