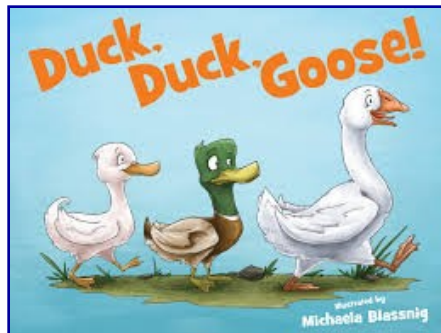

Themes:

Discussion Points:

- Where do you think the little ducks were going and why were they going there?
- How would you describe this story?
- How do you think this story got to be so 'busy'?
- Have you ever heard of a 'gnu'? Would you normally expect to see one riding in a canoe? Where would you expect to find one?
- What other animals appear in the story?
- Which one is your favourite and why?
- Looking at the cover, one duck is white and one is green and brown. Do you know why? Do you think they are different types of ducks?
- Look closely at the illustrations. Where does goose appear in the story?
- As a class, continue the story, thinking up who else the ducks could meet up with in their travels and make friends with.

Activity:

- If you don't already know the game Duck, Duck, Goose, find out about it and then play it as a class.
- The ducks saw pirates on their travels. Make your own pirate hats and pirate eye patches and display these in your class.
