

Where's Dad Hiding?

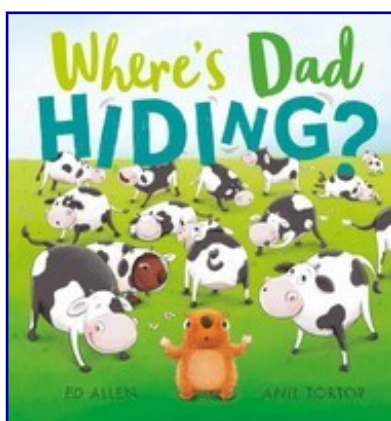

Discussion Points and activities:

- Looking at the front cover of the story, can you tell what animal this story is going to about?
- What do you know about this animal?
- Is hide-and-seek a game that you like to play?
- Who do you like to play it with and why?
- Have you ever played it with your Mum or Dad?
- What are some other things that you like to do or play with your Mum or Dad?
- Where is the sneakiest place that you have ever hid from someone? How long did it take them to find you?
- Hide-and-seek is a game that you can play without any equipment. As a class, come up with a list of other fun games and activities that you can do that don't require any equipment.
- Who was driving the bus? Can you remember the other animals that were on the bus too?
- What toys were in the toy shop window?
- Which animal is always with Dad when he is hiding? Can you spot it on every page? Do you think it enjoyed playing along?
- Do you think Dad enjoyed the game too?
- Do you think little wombat was starting to getting worried that he couldn't find his Dad?
- Play a class game of hide-and-seek. You may like to use dress ups and disguises, just like the Dad in the story.
- Choose your favourite scene from the story and paint or draw your own version of it.
