

All I Want for Christmas is Rain

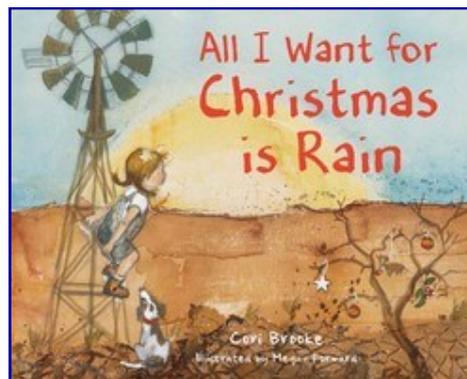

Themes:

Discussion Questions:

- Jane only had one wish for Christmas - rain. Why did she want it so much?
- How do you think she knew, even at a young age, that rain was so important for her family farm?
- What characteristics did she show by hatching her plan to ask Santa for rain?
- Do you know what it is called when there is no rain?
- Why is rain so important? Who relies on it? Make a list of all the things that are affected when there isn't any rain.
- If you could wish for one thing for Christmas or your birthday that wasn't a toy or a thing, what would it be?
- Why is this important to you?
- 'When I woke Christmas morning I heard a sound: A splashing and dripping that echoed around. In a flash I skipped around the tree, past all the presents waiting for me.' Do you think that we all want and have too many material things? Discuss.
- Describe how you think Jane and her family felt when they woke that Christmas morning to rain?
- Does this story make you feel more appreciative for the things that you do have?
- Can you recall what shops were in the town? If you are from the city, do you think this is what a small country town would like? If you are from the country, how similar is this to your town?
- Make lists of the things that are different and the same from the city to the country.
- Do you think people who live in the city realise how hard life on a farm is when there is a drought? Discuss this as a class.

Activities:

- Think about how different life on a farm is before and after rain. Draw your own contrasting picture to highlight the difference.
- Make and decorate your own version of an 'Aussie Christmas tree' just like the one in the story.
